Getting the North Pole Postmark

To show a little extra holiday spirit this year, the postage stamps on **holiday cards** can be delivered bearing the North Pole postmark.

Here's how to do it:

- 1) Personalize greeting cards as usual.
- 2) Address the envelopes.
- 3) Put a **holiday stamp** on the envelope.
- 4) Put all of the envelopes in a larger envelope—or preferably a **Priority Mail®** box.
- 5) Put postage on the larger envelope or box.
- 6) We recommend mailing by Dec. 8 to:
