Growing the USPS “Returns” Business: Nobody Does It Better!

The Postal Service™ wants to be America’s “Return Shipper of Choice” and has a portfolio of return products that can meet the needs of merchants of all sizes.

A USPS® training video is now available for employees that is titled “Growing the USPS ‘Returns’ Business: Nobody Does It Better!”. This video emphasizes the processes for returns, improving the visibility of the shipments and the \$3 billion worth of returns business.

After the holidays, consumers are returning gifts that they have received, along with all types of merchandise they have ordered and have decided to return for various reasons. The United States Postal Service® wants this business and has the infrastructure to support it. Whatever the reason, a “hassle-free” customer returns policy helps merchants win their first order and a positive returns experience earns repeat business.

eCommerce marketplace revenue is expected to grow about 9.5 percent annually through 2018 according to Forrester Research. Shipments to consumers are outpacing shipments to businesses. By 2018, total online sales in the U.S. are expected to reach close to \$414 billion. As eCommerce shopping grows, so does the demand for user-friendly “Returns” solutions.

Why should customers choose the Postal Service for their “Returns”?

- **Convenience:** With more than 31,000 retail Post Offices™ throughout the U.S., we offer convenient choices for customers to deposit their return packages. We offer Package Pickup from the customer’s doorstep during regular mail delivery (132 million addresses) and conveniently placed collection boxes (approximately 160,000).
- **Affordability:** Merchants can better manage shipping expenses because USPS up-front pricing means no surprises. There are no surcharges or fees

to print return labels. We offer ounce-based pricing for lightweight return shipments.

- **Flexibility:** USPS has convenient return shipping label printing options that can fit customers’ needs and has IT support capabilities. A return label can be made available with the order or a PDF image is emailed to the customer when requested. Through the Print and Deliver service, merchants can request that a USPS return label be delivered to their customer’s address by a USPS carrier, be picked up by their customer at one of 31,000 Post Offices or made available at one of 2,500 Self-Service Kiosks.

Policies, Procedures, and Forms Updates

Manuals

DMM Revision: New Mailing Standards for Domestic Mailing Services Products

Effective January 25, 2015, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) in various sections to reflect minor mail classification updates, product and service enhancements, and to eliminate outdated references, publications, and forms, as follows:

Publication 109 and Publication 91

To provide a single, more comprehensive technical reference guide related to Intelligent Mail® package barcodes, including extra service barcodes, the Postal Service began incorporating information from multiple technical guides into the *Intelligent Mail Package Barcode (IMpb) Implementation Guide for: Confirmation Services and Electronic Verification System (eVS) Mailers*, in early 2014. As a result, Publication 91, *Confirmation Services Technical Guide*, was officially retired in March 2014. Subsequently, Publication 109, *Special Services Technical Guide: Postal Forms and Labels (Domestic Service Only)*, will be retired effective January 25, 2015. The DMM will be revised to remove all references to Publication 109 and Publication 91, and replace them with *Intelligent Mail Package Barcode (IMpb) Implementation Guide for: Confirmation Services and Electronic Verification System (eVS) Mailers* reference, as applicable. Package Services — Bound Printed Matter

On April 18, 2013, the Postal Service published a Final Rule [FR Doc No: 2013-08721] modifying the eligibility requirements for mailers to qualify for automation prices. This included a requirement of Full-Service compliance for Bound Printed Matter flats. On December 27, 2013, the Postal Service provided notice [FR Doc No: 2013-30705] of a partial deferral of the Full-Service compliance date. Subsequently, all of the new DMM language provided in the final rule was removed, instead of being revised accordingly. This article serves to revise the DMM language for flats mailed at Bound Printed Matter prices accordingly, which allows a barcode discount when optionally prepared as a Full-Service mailing. This change will align the DMM language with the postage statements and systems changes completed at the time of the partial deferral.

Extra, Additional, and Mailer Services

Bulk Proof of Delivery

The Postal Service will revise the DMM to streamline the current language for Bulk Proof of Delivery (BPOD) service. Mailers will continue to find the technical standards for BPOD in revisions to the *Intelligent Mail Package Barcode (IMpb) Implementation Guide for: Confirmation Services and Electronic Verification System (eVS) Mailers Supplement for Bulk Proof of Delivery Services*, available on RIBBS at: <https://ribbs.usps.gov/index.cfm?>

Package Intercept

Standards for USPS Package Intercept® service will be revised to charge the intercept fee once the USPS® successfully intercepts the mailpiece, instead of when the intercept request is initiated. Any applicable postage and fees for the mailpiece will be charged based on the customer's method of established payment.

Postage Payment Methods

Alternate Postage

Alternate Postage is a regular offering following a market test, which began on January 2, 2011, as *Alternate Postage Payment Method for Greeting Cards*. Alternate Postage is a postage payment mechanism for single-piece First-Class Mail® letters or postcards, addressed to any domestic location by the sender, that weigh no more than one ounce each. Participation in the Alternate Postage program requires, at a minimum, that postage be debited from a Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) account, that a signed marketing agreement exists between the mailer and the USPS, that the mailpieces are USPS-approved and bear: unique Intelligent Mail® barcodes, a special Facing Identification Mark (FIM E), and an approved permit imprint indicia (or optionally, an approved picture permit imprint indicia with applicable markings, for no additional charge). The program requires authorization through the Manager, New Solutions, Mailing Services, United States Postal Service, 475 L'Enfant Plaza SW, Room 5440, Washington, DC 20260-4440.

Refunds and Stamp Exchanges

The Postal Service will provide a clarification in the DMM language that applies to stamp exchanges for both ordinary and precanceled postage stamps affixed to unusable commercial envelopes and postcards. This revision

will replace minor wording that was inadvertently condensed into the DMM text in a prior DMM revision.

5.0 Package Intercept

5.1 Description of Service

5.1.1 Basic Standards

[Revise the text of 5.1.1 to read as follows:]

Package Intercept service provides a method for customers to authorize redirection of any mailable domestic mailpiece with a tracking barcode under 5.1.2, unless otherwise ineligible under 5.1.3. Only the sender or authorized representative can request Package Intercept. If the item is found and redirected to the sender, to a new delivery address, or to a Post Office as Hold For Pickup, the Package Intercept fee is collected and the item is subject to additional postage charged under 5.2. Package Intercept requests are active for seven business days from the date of the request. Interception of eligible mailpieces is not guaranteed. Requests must be made as provided under 5.4.

5.1.2 Eligibility

[Revise the text of 5.1.2 to read as follows:]

Except under 5.1.3, Package Intercept service is available for Priority Mail Express, Priority Mail, First-Class Mail, First-Class Package Service, Parcel Select, Standard Post, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, or Library Mail mailpieces with a tracking barcode, addressed to, from, or between domestic destinations (608.2.0) that do not require a customs declarations label, and measuring not more than 108 inches in length and girth combined. Package Intercept, redirect to sender option only, is available for eligible matter mailed using Registered Mail service.

5.1.3 Ineligible

5.2 Postage and Fees

Customers must pay a nonrefundable per-piece fee once the USPS successfully intercepts the mailpiece. Priority Mail Express, Priority Mail, and First-Class Mail pieces being redirected to the sender are not relabeled or subject to additional postage. Intercepted Parcel Select, Standard Post, Bound Printed Matter, Media Mail, or Library Mail pieces that are redirected to the sender, and all intercepted mailpieces that are redirected to a new delivery address or a Post Office as Hold For Pickup (508.7.0), are relabeled and handled as a new Priority Mail piece. The new Priority Mail piece is charged Priority Mail Commercial Base prices from the location where intercepted to the new destination based on the dimensions, weight, and zone of the piece or the flat rate price, if applicable, along with any applicable extra services fees. Postage and fee payments are as follows:

- a. For retail customers, the Package Intercept fee may be paid by credit or debit card at www.usps.com. Payment of any applicable postage and fees for the new mailpiece will be charged at the time of the intercept when possible, or otherwise will be collected from the recipient as postage due upon delivery.
- b. For commercial customers, payment of the Package Intercept fee and any applicable postage and fees for the new mailpiece must be processed through the mailer's Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) account.

5.3 Adding Extra Services

Customers may request, and pay additional postage under 5.2, for extra services on the new Priority Mail piece being redirected to a new address or a Post Office for Hold For Pickup. Extra services may not be added to items being redirected to the sender. The relabeled item will be assigned a new Intelligent Mail package barcode (IMpb) applicable to the extra service purchased. All available USPS scans for the extra service will be available to the customer at no charge. Only the following extra services may be added:

- a. Adult Signature Required.
- b. Adult Signature Restricted Delivery.
- c. Insurance (if the original shipment included insurance and only for the original value stated).
- d. Signature Confirmation.

[Revise the title of 5.4 to read as follows:]

5.4 Requests for Intercept

Packages designated for redirection to a new address provided by the mailer that are undeliverable as addressed will be returned to sender as provided in 2.0.

Customers participating in the Alternate Postage payment program, must, at a minimum, meet the following requirements:

- a. Have a Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) account link with USPS;
- b. Have a signed marketing agreement between the mailer and the USPS;
- c. Submit production-quality mailpieces to USPS for pre-approval and have received subsequent USPS approval; and

- d. Have approved mailpieces that bear unique Intelligent Mail barcodes, an approved permit imprint indicia or picture permit imprint indicia and any associated required markings located in the upper-right hand corner of the mailpiece, and a special facing identification mark (FIM E) (see 708.9.2e).

IMM Revision: Individual Country Listings for Bangladesh, France, and Morocco

Effective January 26, 2015, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) to reflect changes to the Individual Country Listings (ICLs) for Bangladesh, France, and Morocco.

The following ICL changes are a result of formal requests made through the Universal Postal Union (UPU) via *International Bureau Circulars* (IBC):

- Bangladesh: As indicated in UPU IBC 149, dated August 25, 2014, Bangladesh is prohibiting bearer cheques, bank drafts, credit cards, cash, and foreign currency in all postal items.

- France: As indicated in UPU IBC 118, dated July 14, 2014, France is prohibiting banknotes, coins that are current and legal tender in France, and precious metals in all postal items.
- Morocco: As indicated in UPU IBC 200, dated November 24, 2014, Morocco is adding the following restrictions: items containing food supplements must be sent with the relevant health certificates, and items of a medical nature must be sent with the relevant prescriptions. Additionally, Morocco is adding

an observation that all commercial items must be accompanied by invoices.

IMM Revision: Postal Qualified Wholesaler and Global Direct Entry Wholesaler Programs

Effective December 25, 2014, the Postal Service™ is revising *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, International Mail Manual (IMM)*® to update references to and mailing addresses for Postal Service personnel involved in the administration of the Postal Qualified Wholesaler and Global Direct Entry® (GDE) Wholesaler programs.

Consequently, we are revising IMM sections 613.1, 622.2, and 623.2, and IMM part 625 to replace references to “the Postal Service’s executive director of Global Business Management” with references to the “director of International Sales,” and to replace references to the “manager of Regional Business Development” with references to the “manager of Global Direct Entry.”

saler has not complied with any of the terms and conditions in IMM 620, the Postal Service's manager of Global Direct Entry will notify that company by email that the company has not complied with the terms and conditions of the GDE Wholesaler Program and that the company will be stricken from the list of approved GDE wholesalers within 30 calendar days. A wholesaler who receives such notification may, within 7 days of receiving such notification, submit an appeal by email to the Postal Service's director of International Sales at globaldirect@usps.com. The appeal must list the reasons why the company should not be stricken from the list of approved GDE wholesalers. The decision of the Postal Service's director of International Sales concerning the appeal is administratively final.

IMM Revision: International Money Orders to Mexico

Effective December 31, 2014, the Postal Service™ will revise *Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service*, International Mail Manual (IMM®) Exhibit 371.2 and the Individual Country Listing for Mexico to note that Mexico will no longer accept the International Postal Money Order Form (MP1) issued by the United States Postal Service®.

The Postal Service is making this change after the Government of Mexico terminated the international agreement that authorized Post Office™ facilities in the United States to sell paper money orders to be cashed in Mexico.

U.S. customers may continue to send funds securely to Mexico by using the Postal Service's Sure Money® (Dinero-Seguro®) service.

Similar to last quarter's shipment, the total quantity of *Mover's Guide* copies sent to your facility may have been reduced. In an effort to reduce waste and account for more customers submitting change-of-address orders online, fewer *Mover's Guide* copies are needed. There are several things you can do to conserve as well:

- Make sure customers are aware that *USPS.com*® is the most convenient, safe, and secure way for customers to submit a change-of-address order.

- Encourage carriers to take ICOA message cards on their routes instead of *Mover's Guide* copies.
- Give *Mover's Guide* copies out to moving customers only.

Important Reminders and Alerts

Alert: The Postal Service™ offers the *Mover's Guide* as a service to our customers to assist them with forwarding mail to new addresses. Remember, provide only one *Mover's Guide* per mover unless the visitor asks for more. In that event, provide no more than three. The Postal Service has determined that this number is sufficient for cus-

tomers who use the *Mover's Guide* to submit a Change of Address Order relating to a move.

Reminders:

- Copies of *Mover's Guide* must be kept behind the counter *ONLY*, not in inner or outer lobbies or on clerk counters.
- Customers unwilling or unable to submit their change of address at www.usps.com should be given a complete, unopened copy of *Mover's Guide*.
- Limit of one *Mover's Guide* per customer. Upon request, up to three can be provided.
- *Mover's Guide* is printed and distributed four times a year.

Shipment Information and Inventory Management

Offices will continue to receive copies of *Mover's Guide* in one or two shipments. The first shipments should arrive by the end of December. The second shipments will arrive 3 to 5 weeks later.

- Boxes with ORANGE stickers are the first shipment for this print run.
- Boxes with GREEN stickers are the second and final shipment for this print run.

Verifying U.S. Postal Service Money Orders

Follow these steps to cash a Postal Service™ money order:

1. Check that the amount does not exceed the legal limit: \$1,000 for domestic, and \$700 for international postal money orders.
2. Check that the proper security features are present:
 - When held to the light, a watermark of Benjamin Franklin is repeated from top to bottom on the left side.
 - When held to the light, a dark line (security thread) runs from top to bottom with the word “USPS” repeated.
 - There should be no discoloration around the dollar amounts, which might indicate the amounts were changes.

3. If the money order seems suspicious, call the U.S. Postal Service Money Order Verification System at 866-459-7822.

Mail addressed to military and diplomatic post offices overseas is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.

A1. Mail addressed to "Any Servicemember," or similar wording such as "Any Soldier," "Sailor," "Airman," or "Marine"; "Military Mail"; etc., is prohibited. Mail must be addressed to an individual or job title such as "Commander," "Commanding Officer," etc.

A2. APO/FPO/DPO addresses shall not include a city and/or country name.

B. Regardless of mail class, a customs declaration (PS Form 2976 or, if the customer prefers, PS Form 2976-A) is required for all items weighing 16 ounces or more or any item (regardless of weight) containing potentially dutiable mail contents (e.g., merchandise or goods) addressed to or from an APO, FPO, or DPO ZIP Code. No customs form is required for items weighing less than 16 ounces when the contents are not potentially dutiable (e.g., documents). The surface area of the address side of the mailpiece must be large enough to contain the applicable customs declaration. The following exceptions apply:

- Known mailers are exempt from providing customs documentation on non-dutiable letters or printed matter. (A known mailer is a business mailer who enters volume mailings through a business mail entry unit (BMEU) or other bulk mail acceptance location, pays postage through an advance deposit account, uses a permit imprint for postage payment, and submits a completed postage statement at the time of entry that certifies that the mailpieces contain no dangerous materials that are prohibited by postal regulations.)
- All federal, state, and local government agencies whose mailings are regarded as "Official Mail" are exempt from providing customs documentation on any item addressed to an APO, FPO, or DPO except for those APOs/FPOs/DPOs to which restriction "B2" applies.
- Prepaid mail from military contractors is exempt, providing the mailpiece is endorsed "Contents for Official Use — Exempt from Customs Requirements."

B2. All federal, state, and local government agencies must complete customs documentation when sending potentially dutiable mail addressed to or from this APO, FPO, or DPO.

C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.

C1. Obscene articles, prints, paintings, cards, films, videotapes, etc., and horror comics and matrices are prohibited.

D. Coffee is prohibited.

E. Medicines (prescription, over-the-counter, vitamins, and supplements) are prohibited when mailed to individuals for human or animal use. This prohibition does not apply when medicines are sent as official mail only between specifically designated agencies such as pharmaceutical distributors, hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies.

E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.

E2. Any matter depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials is prohibited. Although religious materials contrary to the Islamic faith are prohibited in bulk quantities, items for the personal use of the addressee are permissible.

E3. Radio transceivers, cordless telephones, global positioning systems, scanners, base stations, and handheld transmitters are prohibited.

F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definitions of firearms in DMM 601.12.1.1. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies. The restriction for mail to this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code does not apply to firearms mailed from this APO/FPO/DPO ZIP Code, provided ATF and USPS regulations are met. Antique firearms are a separate category defined in DMM 601.12.1.1h and ATF regulations; they do not require an ATF form.

F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are prohibited in any class of mail.

F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot.22 caliber rifle per individual.

G. Only letters, flats, and Periodicals are authorized. Parcels of any class are prohibited.

H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.

H1. Pork or pork by-products are prohibited.

I. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions:

- Maximum length 20 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 12 inches.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 68 inches.

This restriction does not apply to registered mail and official government mail marked MOM.

I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.

I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.

J. Parcels may not exceed 108 inches in length and girth combined.

K. Mail that includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines, and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."

L. All official mail is prohibited.

M. Fruits, vegetables, animals, and living plants are prohibited.

N. Registered mail is prohibited.

O. Delivery status information for Extra Services is not available on USPS.com.

P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.

Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.

R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM 601.12.7, are prohibited.

R1. Materials used in the production of alcoholic beverages (i.e., distilling material, hops, malts, yeast, etc.) are prohibited.

S. Mail of all classes must fit in a mail sack. Mail may not exceed the following dimensions and weight:

- Maximum length 12 inches.
- Maximum width 12 inches.
- Maximum height 5 1/2 inches.
- Maximum weight 25 pounds.

The maximum length and girth combined may not exceed 47 inches.

T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.

U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."

U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 13 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Videotapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R, regardless of weight.

U2. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail letters only when addressed to Box R.

U3. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.

U4. Mail addressed to Box C is limited to 2 pounds, regardless of class.

V. Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) not available from any origin.

V1. USPS Tracking is not available.

W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage, may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings, are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.

X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail items (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 13 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.

Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail items only. All Periodicals, Standard Mail items, and Package Services items (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Z. No outside pieces (OSPs).

Z1. The following restriction is applicable only to International Service Centers (ISC)/Exchange Offices. An Anti-Pilferage Seal (Item No O817E or O818A) is required on all pouches and sacks.

Post Offices, classified stations, branches, and contract postal units may display this poster at their option. If the poster is displayed, it should be placed on the community bulletin board located in the Post Office™ box lobby and not in the main retail (full service) lobby. The posters also may be posted in a prominent location where letter carriers will be able to see them before or after they go out on their routes. The Board currently has contracts with BlackRock Institutional Trust Company, N.A., to manage the F, C, S, and I Fund assets. The F, C, S, and I Funds invest in commingled trust funds, in which the assets of tax-deferred employee benefit plans are combined and invested together. The F, C, S, and I Funds and the BlackRock funds are passively managed index funds.

Federal Income Tax Withholding

Effective Pay Period 03-2015, payroll checks will reflect changes in the withholding of federal taxes. All information in this article is based on Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Notice 1036, revised December 2014. The Early Release Copies of the Percentage Method Tables for Income Tax Withholding will appear in the IRS Publication 15 (Circular E), *Employer's Tax Guide*.

The biweekly personal exemption value for each federal tax allowance will increase from \$151.90 to \$153.80 per allowance. In addition, the dollar amounts for the withholding tables have changed. The existing withholding rates (10%, 15%, 25%, 28%, 33%, 35%, and 39.6%) did not change.

- Commuter Program (CPP) up to the transit/parking pre-tax limits.
- Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP).
- Health Benefits (HP)
 - Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB), unless employee declined the pre-tax benefit.
 - USPS Non-Career Employee (NCE) Health Benefits, only if employee opted for pre-tax contributions.
- Flexible Spending Accounts (FSA).
- Health Savings Account (HSA).
- Traditional Thrift Savings Plan (TSP).

When calculating your federal taxes, remember to subtract from your gross earnings your withholding allowance amount as well as these pre-tax contribution amounts to determine your federal taxable wage amount.

Upon submission of your federal tax return, you are urged to review your federal tax withholdings particularly if you owed a significant amount of money or were due a

large refund. If necessary, update your Federal Form W-4 (Employee's Withholding Allowance Certificate).

To determine the amount of withholding, follow steps 1 through 10:

1. Determine biweekly gross wages from earnings statement.
2. Determine biweekly Traditional TSP employee contributions from earnings statement.
3. Determine biweekly FSA contributions from earnings statement. If applicable, add the amounts from both the FSA Dependent Child (FSADC) Sub-Account and the FSA Health Care (FSAHC) Sub-Account.
4. Determine biweekly FEHB pre-tax employee contribution from earnings statement (abbreviated as HP).
5. Determine biweekly USPS NCE pre-tax employee contribution from earnings statement. **Note:** Generally NCE contributions are treated as post-tax monies.
6. Determine biweekly CPP employee contributions from earnings statement.
7. Determine biweekly FEDVIP employee contributions from earnings statement.

8. Determine biweekly HSA contribution from earnings statement.
9. Multiply the number of exemptions claimed by the biweekly exemption value of \$153.80 (withholding allowance). The federal tax line on the earnings statement shows the number of exemptions claimed (e.g., S1 = single with one exemption, M3 = married with three exemptions).
10. Subtract the amounts in step 2 (Traditional TSP), step 3 (FSA), step 4 (FEHB), step 5 (USPS NCE, only if appropriate), step 6 (CPP), step 7 (FEDVIP), step 8 (HSA) and step 9 (exemptions) from step 1 (biweekly gross wages). The balance is the amount subject to withholding.
11. Determine into which range this amount falls on the Federal Income Tax Withholding Table; follow the instructions listed in the table.

The following is an example of how to compute federal income taxes for a Federal Employee Retirement System (FERS) employee who claims married with three exemptions, and makes pre-tax contributions to the TSP, FSA, FEHB, CPP, and FEDVIP.

Example: A FERS employee receives \$3,826.35 as biweekly gross wages. The employee makes the following contributions: 11 percent of basic earnings (for this example, all of the gross \$ is basic; $\text{basic} \times 0.11 = \420.90) per pay period (PP) to TSP; \$65 per PP to FSADC; \$95 per PP to FSAHC; \$148.46 per PP to FEHB, \$105 for this PP to the CPP; and \$57.23 per PP to the GEHA PPO High Option Dental Premium. The employee claims "married" with three exemptions (M3 on the federal tax line of the earnings

statement). Using the information provided in the Federal Income Tax Withholding Table in this article, federal taxes are computed as follows:

Biweekly gross wages	\$3,826.35
Minus Traditional Thrift Savings Plan contributions	-420.90
Minus Flexible Spending Account Dependent Care contributions	-65.00
Minus Flexible Spending Account Health Care contributions	-95.00
Minus Federal Employees Health Benefits contributions	-148.46
Minus Commuter Program pre-tax contributions	-105.00
Minus Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program contributions	-57.23
Minus Exemptions (3 x \$153.80)	-461.40
Amount of wages subject to withholding	\$2,473.36

To complete the computation, refer to the Married/Biweekly segment of the Federal Income Tax Withholding Table. The amount of wages subject to withholding (\$2,473.36) falls within the "over \$1,040 but not over \$3,212" range. Using the information provided within that range, the final computation is as follows:

Amount subject to withholding	\$2,473.36
Subtract \$1,040 from \$2,473.36	1,433.36
Multiply \$1,433.36 by .15 (15%)	215.00
Add from the table	70.90
Add \$215.00 and \$70.90	285.90
Total federal income tax* that should be withheld from this employee's biweekly check	\$285.90

* Rounding may vary this total by a few cents.

Federal Taxation Percentages for Supplemental Wages

USPS® employees are reminded that the percentages used to tax supplemental wages are different from the normal taxation percentages. Supplemental wages may include, but are not limited to, annual leave exchange, awards, back-pay awards, prizes, severance pay, and reimbursements for moving expenses. *The American Jobs Creation Act of 2004* and Section 31.3402(g)-1 of IRS regulations created a two-tiered taxation rate for supplemental wages, effective January 1, 2005. These regulations apply to all supplemental payments received by USPS employees in the United States, as well as the U.S. territories.

With the passage of the *American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012* (H.R.8), the marginal income tax rate for high-income

taxpayers was increased for wages paid on and after January 1, 2013.

Current regulations provide for taxation of supplemental wages up to a total of 1 million dollars within a calendar year at a *mandatory* withholding rate of 25 percent. Regulations also provide for a *mandatory* withholding rate of 39.6 percent (or the highest rate of income tax for the year) for any supplemental wages paid in excess of 1 million dollars within a calendar year. These regulations remain in effect until taxation percentages are once again changed by Congress and the IRS.

Information Security

Holiday Safety: Protecting Credit Card Information



With the holiday season approaching, the Corporate Information Security Office recommends employees follow these tips to protect their credit card information:

- Protect your information while shopping or banking online. Use only sites whose Web addresses begin with "HTTPS://."
- Close your browser after you have been on a site that asks for credit card information. Clear your login name and passwords, if using a public computer.

Change passwords monthly and use different login IDs and passwords for each website.

- When possible, use a credit card instead of a debit card. Federal laws provide consumers more protection for credit cards.
- Keep track of bank and credit card statements, as well as retail purchase receipts, to more quickly identify unauthorized transactions.
- Be wary of emails that ask for credit card information. In most cases, these emails are either a phishing attack or spam to collect credit card information. If you're unsure whether the email is legitimate, go directly to the company's website. Don't use links in emails.
- Take advantage of free annual credit reports available from the three credit bureaus (Equifax, Experian, and TransUnion). Go directly to their websites, since there are many sites that charge for this service.
- Shred outdated credit card or bill statements.

If you think you are a victim of credit card theft or fraud, contact your financial institution immediately.

Pictorial Postmarks Announcement

As a community service, the Postal Service™ offers pictorial postmarks to commemorate local events celebrated in communities throughout the nation. A list of events for which pictorial postmarks are authorized appears below. The sponsor of the pictorial postmark appears in *italics* under the date. Also provided are illustrations of these postmarks.

People attending these local events may obtain the postmark in person at the temporary Post Office™ station established there. Those who cannot attend the event but who wish to obtain the postmark may submit a mail order request. Pictorial postmarks are available only for the dates indicated, and *requests must be postmarked no later than 30 days following the requested pictorial postmark date.*

All requests must include a stamped envelope or postcard bearing at least the minimum First-Class Mail® postage. Items submitted for postmark may not include

postage issued after the date of the requested postmark. Such items will be returned unserved.

Customers wishing to obtain a postmark should affix stamps to any envelope or postcard of their choice, address the envelope or postcard to themselves or others, insert a card of postcard thickness in envelopes for sturdiness, and tuck in the flap. Place the envelope or postcard in a larger envelope and address it to: Pictorial Postmarks, followed by the Name of the Station, Address, City, State, ZIP+4® Code, as listed below.

Customers can also send stamped envelopes and postcards without addresses for postmark, as long as they supply a larger envelope with adequate postage and their return address. After applying the pictorial postmark, the Postal Service returns the items (with or without addresses) under addressed protective cover.

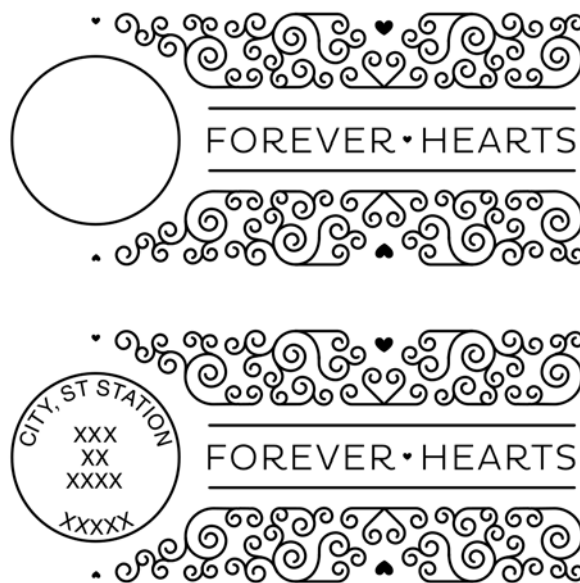

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes through the mail. There is no charge for the postmark up to a quantity of 50.

For more than 50, customers have to pay five cents each. All orders must be postmarked by April 8, 2015.

How to Order the First-Day-of-Issue Digital Color or Traditional Postmarks

Customers have 60 days to obtain the first-day-of-issue postmarks by mail. They may purchase new stamps at their local Post Office™, by telephone at 800-STAMP-24, or at The Postal Store® website at www.usps.com/shop.

Traditional Postmarks

Customers should affix the stamps to envelopes of their choice, address them to themselves or others, or provide a self-addressed return envelope with sufficient postage large enough to accommodate the canceled item. Mail the request to the corresponding city of issuance. There is no charge for the first 50 postmarks. There is a 5-cent charge for each additional postmark over 50. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment. After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service™ will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

All postmark requests should go to the first-day-of-issue city. The first-day-of-issue city Post Office will then forward in bulk all postmark requests to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992 by respective Post Offices.

Digital Color Postmarks

Only select stamp issues offer a digital color postmark. Customers may submit #6 or #10 envelopes constructed of paper rated as "laser safe." The Postal Service recommends envelopes of 80-pound Accent Opaque, acid-free, 9/16" side seams with no glue on the flap. The maximum size of all digital color postmarks is 2" high x 4" long. Allow

sufficient space on the envelope to accommodate the postmark. Do not use self-adhesive labels for addresses on the envelope. Two test envelopes must be included. There is a minimum of 10 envelopes at 50 cents per postmark required at the time of servicing. Customers should submit a check, money order, or credit card for payment.

The Postal Service reserves the right to not accept hand-painted and other cachet envelopes that are not compatible with our digital color postmark equipment. The Postal Service also reserves the right to substitute traditional black rubber postmarks if use of nonspecified envelopes results in poor image quality or damage to equipment.

Customers should affix the stamps to the envelopes and address them to themselves or others for return through the mail. Or, they may include an additional self-addressed return envelope, large enough to accommodate their canceled items, with sufficient postage affixed for return of their postmarked items. Mail the request for a first-day-of-issue digital color postmark to the corresponding city of issuance. Post Offices will then forward all customer requests for digital color postmarks to Cancellation Services, Stamp Fulfillment Services, PO Box 449992, Kansas City, MO 64144-9992.

After applying the first-day-of-issue postmark, the Postal Service will return the envelopes to the customer by U.S. Mail.

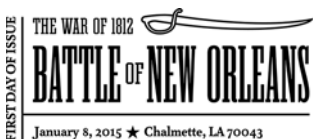
