HEADWEAR
State Size and Style When Ordering

Style A
Cadet Gray Serge crown with black open cane band. Perfect ventilation. Furnished complete with detachable braid band which fits on over cane band making it suitable for use the year around.



Style "B" same as "A" but with solid band and earflaps

Style C
For Summer wear, Cadet Gray Serge, bell crown with black cane band. Perfect ventilation, exceptionally light and cool.



HELMET

Built for service in sun and rain. Hard pressed fibre covered with water resistant regulation blue shirting. White under-crown. Green painted water-repellent underbrim. Rolled edge. The floating, suspended sweat band permits ventilation. Adjustable head size and chin strap. Cool, comfortable and durable.

HEADWEAR
All Caps Made With Eyelets for Badges

Style S or T
Semi-Military Style, with extreme bell, four inches high in front. Lined throughout.



Style S is Cloth—Style T is Serge

Style "T" may be had with open cane band for summer wear. Style "T" may be had with ear flaps for winter wear.

Style D or E
Regulation bell shape stiff crown. Suitable for wear throughout the year.



Style D is Cloth—Style E is Serge

(Cloth or Serge) State Fabric wanted


Combination Winter Cap, bell crown, black cloth trimmings. Has same appearance as Style D, but made with inside pull-down, lined with velvet, protecting head, ears, temples and forehead. An ideal cap for Winter.
